The George & Betty St. Angelo Memorial Scholarship

In memory of the vision and commitment to social justice by George & Betty St. Angelo, UMAIE and Seminars International are able to grant two \$2,000 travel scholarships to students from UMAIE member institutions applying to UMAIE courses.

The scholarship is designed to broaden access to off-campus/study abroad program participation. Successful applicants will have demonstrated financial need and will fit one or more of these diverse groups:

- Underrepresented racial/ethnic identities
- First generation college students
- Students identifying as LGBTQ
- First time travel abroad

General Eligibility

- Applicants must be enrolled in an undergraduate degree program at a UMAIE member institution.
- Applicants must be in academic and disciplinary good standing.
- Applicants must be approved to study off-campus/abroad by their home institution.
- A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required.
- Financial need documented by a financial aid award letter from the current academic year. If you cannot access this information, please address your financial need in detail within the essay.

Application Process

1. Personal details
2. A 500-word essay that answers the following questions:
 - Why are you interested in the chosen country/course?
 - How does this program complement or fit into your academic work?
 - Will you have other opportunities during your academic career to study off-campus/abroad?
 - What financial need or special circumstances apply to your situation?
 - What effects will your experience off-campus/abroad have on your studies, career, and life?
3. The name and contact information of one on-campus reference.

*NOTE: This person will not need to submit a letter of reference, but may be contacted to speak about your qualifications.

Deadline and Submission Information

- Applications for January 2018 must be submitted by April 15, 2017 to the home institution study abroad advisor in conjunction with a complete UMAIE course application.
- Submissions will be reviewed by the UMAIE Scholarship Committee and approved by the UMAIE Board. Scholarship selection decisions will be sent on May 1, 2017 together with UMAIE course admission decisions.
