## Global Citizenship Award — 2015-2016

The University of St. Thomas Global Citizenship Award honors a member(s) of the St. Thomas community whose personal or professional work brings the concept of global citizenship to their department, classroom, residence hall or student club.

The award is open to all faculty (adjuncts included), staff and students of the University of St. Thomas.

### **Nomination and Award Process**

Nominations are accepted from any St. Thomas faculty (including adjunct), staff, student or alumni. The International Programs staff is comprised of the offices of International Students and Scholars, International Admissions, Graduate Admissions, Study Abroad, ELS Language Center, and the Center for Global & Local Engagement. International Programs staff will select a candidate or candidates from the nominations submitted.

The presentation of the award(s) will be made at the 27<sup>th</sup> Annual International Dinner that takes place on **Saturday, April 30, 2016**. Recipients will be notified of award by letter and will receive two tickets to attend the International Dinner where they will receive a certificate and a desktop award globe.

### **Nomination Criteria**

Deadline for nominations has been **EXTENDED** to **Friday, April 1, 2016**. Completed Nomination Form is required and must be submitted either in person to the Center for Global & Local Engagement (Murray Herrick 212), by campus mail to Mail #5026 or by email to [global@stthomas.edu](mailto:global@stthomas.edu). Candidates must be a St. Thomas faculty (adjuncts included), staff or student.

International Programs staff members are excluded from receiving the award.

Candidates must demonstrate Global Citizenship via one or more of the following:

- Consistent efforts to be respectful and inclusive of other cultures and viewpoints.
- Contributions that improve the climate at the University of St. Thomas for other cultures and people.
- Connections made between the University of St. Thomas community and the world.
